

METER TECHNICIAN

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

This position reports directly to the Manager of Metering with functional responsibilities to the Lead Meter Technician.

- The position will assemble, install, and maintain all revenue metering installations, including A Base and S Base meters, meter panels, both single phase and three phase, and all associated instrument transformers and wiring.
- Cross-phase analysis of complex meter installations, troubleshooting the power measurement and communication links to both Retail and Wholesale installations.
- Will inform customers of service requirements, energy saving measures, and other public relations services. Assemble, install and maintain all non-revenue and special metering installations.
- Maintain accurate records on metering installations; ensure their continued accuracy and co-ordinate timely re-verification of metering in accordance with the requirements of Industry Canada.

QUALIFICATIONS

- A Journeyperson Metering Certificate that is EDA accredited with a college diploma in electrical engineering at the Technician or Technologist level eligible for O.A.C.E.T.T. accreditation.
- A valid Class 'G' Driver's License is required for this position.
- Candidates without an E.D.A. Metering Certificate or experience at the Journeyman level may be considered at an Apprenticeship level in accordance with relevant qualifications and experience on condition of the successful completion of the E.D.A. Metering Technician entrance exam.
